HEMPSTEAD FFA PROJECT SHOW POULTRY RULES

- 1. All poultry will be ordered by the Ag Science Teachers. It is the responsibility of the student to contact the Ag Science Teacher on how many broilers will be ordered. Payment is due when the broilers are ordered.
- 2. Exhibitors must order and start with 25 birds (NO LESS).
- 3. All pens must be grade "A" as determined by the judge.
- 4. All broilers must weigh 5 lbs. To be eligible for the FFA Show.
- 5. Two pens of three broilers may be shown, no more than two alternates may be used as reserve birds.
- 6. The exhibitor is responsible for the dressing and packaging of the birds and delivering them to the buyer within 7 days after the Ag Show. They are responsible for getting the buyer to sign the deposition slip and returning it to the Ag Science teachers.
- 7. Only the exhibitor and student helpers will be allowed in the judging ring during the broiler show.
- 8. All FFA General Rules will be enforced.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct by exhibitors and or parents will not be tolerated and could result in removal from the grounds and disqualification from the Ag Show & Sale
